

## **Immunisation policy**

Clyde Nursery Ltd recognises that, where possible, children are vaccinated in accordance with their age.

If children are not vaccinated, it is the responsibility of parents/carers to inform the Nursery to ensure that staff, other children and parents/carers are not exposed to any unnecessary risks.

The Nursery must be made aware of any children in the Nursery who are not vaccinated in accordance with their age.

Information regarding immunisations should be recorded on children's registration documents and updated as and when required, this will also happen as the child transitions through Nursery.

The UK's immunisation schedule is as follows:

In the circumstances of an outbreak of an infectious disease, such as Tetanus, Hepatitis C and Rubella, staff are recommended to have the vaccination, or ensure these vaccinations are up to date. These vaccinations are free to staff if they confirm at the time of booking the appointment that they are a Nursery Practitioner.
